

New video card in Fedora.

If you put in the new card, the system won't even come up with the old drivers (say, for example, the .304 drivers)...and if you try to update the drivers with the old card, you can't. So:

Put in old card, boot the system.

Download drivers for new card from nvidia site to Desktop.

Shut down, put in new card, boot.

At kernel choices, enter e (for edit)...brings up loader.

Find parm that has 'rhgb'...change to 'text 3'....hit F10

su, yum remove *nvidia*

cd to /home/xxx/Desktop

sh the nvidia.newdriver.run

it finds nouveau drivers...unhooks them says to try again.

Try again, goes through installation, works perfectly.
