New video card in Fedora.

If you put in the new card, the system won't even come up with the old drivers (say, for example, the . 304 drivers)...and if you try to update the drivers with the old card, you can't. So:

Put in old card, boot the system.

Download drivers for new card from nvidia site to Desktop.

Shut down, put in new card, boot.

At kernel choices, enter e (for edit)...brings up loader.

Find parm that has 'rhgb'...change to 'text 3'....hit F10

su, yum remove \*nvidia\*

cd to /home/xxx/Desktop

sh the nvidia.newdriver.run

it finds nouveau drivers...unhooks them says to try again.

Try again, goes through installation, works perfectly.
